### 1. Overview

We have modified the USB driver (new file version: 6.0.01.000) because there is a problem that the emulator does not start up correctly when the USB Adapter for E6000/E8000 Emulator (HS6000EIU01; hereafter referred to as the USB adapter) is in use to connect the E8000, E8000S, E6000, or E6000H emulator to certain host computers, in which Windows<sup>®</sup> 98SE\* has been installed. This problem can be solved by updating the USB driver on the host computer.

Note: Windows<sup>®</sup> 98SE is an abbreviation for Microsoft<sup>®</sup> Windows<sup>®</sup> 98 Second Edition operating system.

#### 2. Conditions

This problem is relevant to certain host computers in which Windows<sup>®</sup> 98SE has been installed. . Updating of the USB driver is only necessary in cases where the emulator does not start up correctly even though Windows<sup>®</sup> 98SE recognizes the USB driver.

#### 3. Solution

Download the USB driver, which is provided as a solution to this problem, and the document 'Updating the USB Driver for the E6000/E8000 Emulator' from one of the following websites to update the USB driver used with a host computer this problem is relevant to.
