Please note that the firmware V1.0.01 attached to the E7 emulator's system software ver.2.0.01 to 2.3.01 has the following problems.

1. Problems

- 1.1 If you start up the host computer with the E7 emulator connected, the current drawn will be about 10 mA higher than that in the case where the E7 emulator is connected after activation of the host computer.
- 1.2 If you start up the host computer with the E7 emulator connected, the E7 emulator test program may not work correctly.

2. Solution

Apply the latest firmware V1.0.02, for which the above problems have been corrected.
