A Note on Using the High-performance Embedded Workshop

Please take note of the following problem in using the High-performance Embedded Workshop:

- With moving workspaces from a directory to another
-

1. Description

If a workspace is opened after moved from the directory where it was created to another, it may not be saved with the following error message dispatched:

Error has occurred whilst saving file XXXXX.hws
You may not have access-permissions for this file or directory.

2. Conditions

This problem occurs if the following conditions are both satisfied:

- (1) The High-performance Embedded Workshop V.4.01.01 or earlier is used for creating workspaces.
- (2) The version control function of the High-performance Embedded Workshop is made valid.

3. Workaround

If you move any workspace from the directory where it was created to another and open it with the version control function made valid, invalidate the version control function once immediately after opening the workspace, and then validate it again by performing the following procedures.

(To switch the version control function of the High-performance Embedded Workshop from the valid state to invalid, deselect it. If it is deselected, all its settings before invalidating it

are maintained.)

- (1) Open the Tools menu and select the Version control and Select command.
The Select Version Control System appears.
- (2) Select None in the Version control systems list box, click the Select button and then OK to close the dialog box.
- (3) Again repeat Step (1).
- (4) Select the tool you want to use among the version control tool in the Version control systems list box. Then click the OK button.

These procedures will allow you to save workspaces.

4. **Schedule of Fixing the Problem**

We plan to fix this problem in the next release of the High-performance Embedded Workshop, V.4.02.00.
