High-performance Embedded Workshop V.3.00.00 through V.4.07.01

2. Descriptions of Revision

2.1 Improvements, Introduction, and Modification Made

The following improvements, introduction, and modification have been made.

(1) Improvements made to Watch functions

Improvements have been made to the Watch functions that are used when High-performance Embedded Workshop manages the following products:

- E8a Emulator Software
- E8 Emulator Software
- E10A-USB Emulator Software
- E10T-USB Emulator Software
- E100 Emulator Software
- E200F Emulator Software
- E6000H Emulator Software
- E6000 Emulator Software
- Simulator debugger for the RX family
- Simulator debugger for the SuperH family

- Simulator debugger for the H8SX, H8S, and H8 families

The improvements made are as follows:

(a) Four functions usable during execution of programs Four functions can be used in the Watch window during execution of programs. And these functions also can be used by executing their commands during execution of programs.

The functions and commands are shown in the table below.

Function	Command
Registering global variables	WATCH_ADD
Deleting variables	WATCH_DELETE
Enabling/disabling the autoupdate function; Used only when you debug programs for which RAM monitoring can be set	WATCH_AUTO_UPDATE
Expanding/folding array-type or structure-type variables	WATCH_EXPAND

(b) The scope-selecting function introduced when variables registered

When you register a variable by using the variable-registering function in the Watch window or the WATCH_ADD command, a scope of the variable can be selected.

(2) Improvements made to Code Coverage functions

Improvements have been made to the Code Coverage functions that are used when High-performance Embedded Workshop manages the following products:

- E100 Emulator Software
- E200F Emulator Software
- AE-5 E6000H Emulator Software
- AE-4 E6000 Emulator Software

The improvements made are as follows:

- (a) Information about coverage measurement saved on files The following items of information can be saved on files:
 - Detailed information
 - Information about the number of executed instructions,

the total number of instructions, and others can be saved on files.

- Disassembly code

The disassembly code corresponding to addresses can be

saved on files.

(b) The Code Coverage window and the code coverage commands synchronized

The functions of the Code Coverage window and the code coverage commands have been synchronized with each other.

- (c) The COVERAGE_DELETE command introduced The command can delete the displayed area of code coverage address by address or file by file.
- (d) The COVERAGE_DISPLAY command improved The command can display the result of code coverage measurement sheet by sheet of the Code Coverage window.
- (e) The COVERAGE_SAVE command improved The command can save the result of code coverage measurement on a file sheet by sheet of the Code Coverage window.
- (f) The COVERAGE_RANGE command improved The command can display the area of code coverage measurement sheet by sheet of the Code Coverage window.
- (3) Improvements made to the Data Coverage window Information about the system stack has been displayed on Task Stack sheet when High-performance Embedded Workshop manages the E100 Emulator Software for the M16 series, and systems designed with either of the following real-time OSes are debugged:
 - Real-time OS M3T-MR30/4 (for the M16C series and R8C family)
 - Real-time OS M3T-MR30 (for the M16C series)
- (4) Introduction of "Real-Time OS Aware Debugging" The debugging functions for the following five real-time OSes have been introduced:
 - M3T-MR30 (for the M16C series; published by Renesas)
 - MR8C/4 (for the R8C family; published by Renesas)
 - RTA-OSEK (for the SH-2A CPU core; published by ETAS)
 - embOS (for the RX family; published by SEGGER)
- (5) Modification made to the way of displaying flags in the Register window

Modification has been made to the way of displaying flags in the Register window that is used when High-performance Embedded Workshop manages the following product:

- Simulator debugger for the RX family

The modified way of displaying flags is as follows:

- The settings of the registers' flags are displayed by default.

2.2 Problems Fixed

The following known problems have been fixed:

(1) Limitation on saving memory content on a Motorola S-record format file

(a) Full update program

The components of High-performance Embedded Workshop to which changes have been made in and after V.3.00.00 are updated; that is, V.3.00.00 through V.4.07.01 can be updated.

(b) Differential update program

The components of High-performance Embedded Workshop to which changes have been made in and after V.4.07.00 are updated; that is, V.4.07.00 and V.4.07.01 can be updated.
